Article I: Name and Identity

The legal name of the corporation is **The Promise Christian Academy, Incorporated**. The organization officially operates under the trade name (DBA) **The Promise Creative Arts Academy (PCAA)**.

Article II: Mission and Philosophy

- **The Primary Mission:** To point children in the right direction by providing a foundation of faith, discipline, and creativity.
- **Vision:** "Empowering every child to discover their purpose and walk boldly toward a brighter future.
- **Core Objectives:** To empower and equip students with the tools necessary to make healthy and responsible decisions.
- **Community Impact:** To heighten awareness about societal distractions and reduce the likelihood of self-sabotaging behaviors.
- **Symbolism:** The organization's logo is a **Rainbow**, representing the biblical promises of God (Genesis 9).

Article III: Organizational Status and Duration

- **Status:** The corporation is a registered **Nonprofit Organization** in the State of Mississippi.
- **Business ID:** 1014726.
- **Duration:** The period of duration is **perpetual**.

Article IV: Purpose and Scope

The purpose of the corporation is to provide educational, developmental, and community programs that support youth growth. This includes:

- **Youth Leadership:** Offering character development and mentorship initiatives.
- **Community Engagement:** Strengthening the community by helping youth grow as responsible contributors to society.
- **Health & Wellness:** Promoting physical and mental well-being for youth and the community.
- **Creative Arts Education:** Providing dance and performing arts instruction.

Article V: Programmatic Curriculum

The Academy shall maintain a diverse curriculum focused on holistic development, designed to point children in the right direction through the following core pillars:

- **Dance & Movement:** Our curriculum points children in the right direction by integrating early childhood cognitive development through Creative Movement (ages 3–6) with advanced technical mastery in Celebratory, Expressive, and Liturgical dance, culminating in high-impact choreographed performances that build collaborative leadership and elite teamwork.
- **Enrichment Activities:** A comprehensive suite of programming including Character Education, Leadership Development, Etiquette, Community Service, and Academic Tutoring to ensure students are well-rounded and community-minded.
- **Personal Growth:** Evidence-based initiatives focused on Group Discussions, Social Skills Development, and Self-Esteem Building to foster emotional intelligence and resilience.
- **Visual Arts:** Specialized instruction in Visual Ministry, teaching the technical and artistic use of flags, streamers, and banners to enhance creative expression and worship.

Article VI: Governance

- **Board of Directors:** The organization is governed by a Board responsible for policy, financial oversight, and ensuring program integrity.
